Bernstein; and for the reasons stated by the Court on the record at the Hearing; and after due deliberation thereon; and good and sufficient cause appearing therefor;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Motion is DENIED. This Order is without prejudice to Eliot I. Bernstein filing a proof of claim in this case.
