In response to Complaint number 2003-51, 109(15C) regarding attorney Christopher Clark Wheeler, Iviewit has compiled two separate responses. The first is from the CEO; P. Stephen Lamont, who is a Columbia law school graduate and the second is from one of the inventors, Eliot I. Bernstein. The reason we have drafted separate responses is that Mr. Lamont who also authored the original Complaint was completely left out of Mr. Wheeler's response, nor carbon copied on any of the materials, he would like his response included as part of the response to be dealt with in its entirety. I have provided a very detailed overview of the information regarding our complaint with hosts of supporting evidence and I have left very little out. It would be best if you start with Mr. Lamont's response and then move onto mine, which will take considerably longer to review.

We have left an analysis of the faulty patents out as it is highly sensitive materials but it can be sent over if further investigation is warranted. We are also sending a copy of these responses to the Honorable Harry Moatz, the Director of Discipline at the United States Patent and Trademark office, so that he may obtain all records submitted on behalf of the Company, which the respondent was responsible for and many now appear missing.
