The Virginia State Bar received your correspondence. All lawyers who practice law in Virginia must be members of the Virginia State Bar. Virginia lawyers must follow certain rules of conduct called the Virginia Rules of Professional Conduct. The Bar enforces those ethics rules, and disciplines lawyers who violate them. This office reviewed your correspondence to ascertain whether it described conduct that might violate a provision of the Rules of Professional Conduct.

Please note that the Virginia State Bar, by law, has limited authority. It cannot address all situations through its complaint process. Please review the enclosed Pamphlet "Complaints About Lawyers" for general information about the complaint process.
