**Re: Determination of Lorraine C. Hoffman in Letter of Dated October 16, 2003 in  
File No. 2003-51, 109 (15C) – Christopher Clark Wheeler, Esq.**

Dear Mr. Turner:

On behalf of Iviewit Holdings, Inc. ("Company"), I write to appeal the determination of Ms. Hoffman based on the following factors:

1. Ms. Hoffman's incorrect assessment that the Company's complaint is a civil dispute rather than a complaint for professional misconduct;
2. Based on the Rules Regulating the Florida Bar, Rule 3-7.4.e, among other Rules, that states:

**(e) No Delay for Civil or Criminal Proceedings.** An investigation shall not be deferred or suspended without the approval of the board even though the respondent is made a party to civil litigation or is a defendant or is acquitted in a criminal action, notwithstanding that either of such proceedings involves the subject matter of the investigation.

3. Based on the default of the Company in *Proskauer Rose LLP v. Iviewit.com, Inc. et. al.*, Case No. CA 01-04671 AB (Circuit Court of the 15th Judicial Circuit in and for Palm Beach County, Florida filed May 2, 2001), no determination was made regarding the allegations set forth in the January 2003 Motion to Amend

Answer and Counterclaim for Damages, thus removing the issues of professional misconduct from the Court and falling back on The Florida Bar.

Withstanding Ms. Hoffman's determination, it seems that between Hon. Jorge Labarga and The Florida Bar, that an effective cloaking device, and safe harbor, has been erected to protect Mr. Wheeler from the investigation of professional misconduct that pertains to our original complaint.

We look forward to your timely review of Ms. Hoffman's determination, and we request The Florida Bar not dispose of records in this complaint for a period of five (5) years.
