In response to Complaint number 2003-51, 109(15C) regarding attorney Christopher Clark Wheeler, Iviewit has compiled two separate responses. The first is from the CEO; P. Stephen Lamont, who is a Columb a law school graduate and the second is from one of the inventors, Eliot I. Bernstein. The reason we have drafted separate responses is that Mr. Lamont who also authored the original Complaint was completely left out of Mr. Wheeler's response, nor carbon copied on any of the materials, he would like his response included as part of the response to be dealt with in it's entirety. I have provided a very detailed overview of the information regarding our complaint with hosts of supporting evidence and I have left very little out.
