

MARS will assimilate the Virginia Space Flight Center and address the need for low-cost, rapid response solutions for small to medium-sized satellites, as well as flight experiments for government, academic and commercial uses. *(Press release)*

Virginia Commonwealth University received a \$100,000 Fulbright grant to explore development of a MBA program in Cairo, Egypt, through a partnership with Helwan University Faculty of Commerce and Business Administration. The program aims to bring corporate planning and strategy to future Egyptian business leaders, and broaden the international scope of curricula at both universities. (*Press release*)
