RESPONDENT'S RESPONSE TO MOTION FOR REHEARING EN BANC AND REQUEST FOR EXPEDITED RULING

Respondent, Ted S. Bernstein, as Successor Trustee of the Shirley Bernstein
Trust ("Trustee"), responds to the *pro se* Petitioner's Motion for Rehearing En Banc:

- 1. On its face, this serial filing is procedurally improper and without merit. If it had been filed by an attorney, or if its filing was aided by an attorney, that person should be sanctioned. The Trustee seeks only its immediate denial.
- 2. The original Petition had no merit, but also was moot. It was properly dismissed. Moreover, there is nothing of exceptional importance in this case. The issues raised seem to be exceptionally important, or obsessively important, to Eliot Ivan Bernstein, but to no one else in the world. Indeed, these issues already have been decided years ago. *Bernstein v. New York*, 591 F. Supp. 2d 448 (S.D.N.Y. 2008).

- 3. In *Bernstein*, the federal judge dismissed with prejudice Eliot Bernstein's "fantastic conspiracy among members of the legal profession, judges and government officials and private individuals and businesses to deprive plaintiffs of what they describe as their 'holy grail' technologies." *Id.* at 452. Judge Scheindlin noted that Eliot Bernstein and other plaintiffs "allege that hundreds of defendants engaged in a massive conspiracy to violate their civil rights and, in the process, contributed to the Enron bankruptcy and the presidency of George W. Bush." *Id.*¹
- 4. This is yet another desperate filing seeking to delay a routine sale of real property, which was approved by a final, non-appealable court order dated May 6, 2015. The pendency of the Petition already has delayed the closing by nearly six months. The Trustee respectfully requests that this Court immediately deny the motion for rehearing en banc to avoid any further delay caused by these improper filings.
