
Thank you for your letter. I apologize for not responding earlier. I am in the process of reviewing several thousand documents that I recently received from counsel for Messrs. Spallina and Tescher, in an effort to attempt to determine what I need to do as Curator to properly administer your father's estate. I will then file the appropriate applications with the probate court to authorize a course of action and then schedule hearings on the issues.

As Curator, I have filed a motion for instructions relating to the Kia SUV, and intend to have that motion heard, at least on a preliminary basis to find out if any estate interested person has a position on the vehicle's disposition, before the end of the month. You should have received a copy.

One point I need to make is that I was appointed temporary Curator of your father's estate only; I do not have any authority to act with respect to his trust, your mother's estate, or your mother's trust. In the event any of those entities is in possession of an asset that belongs to your father's estate, then as Curator I will seek to obtain the probate court's authorization to pursue recovery of the asset. However, to the extent you, individually, have claims against your father's trust, your mother's estate, and/or your mother's trust, it is not the Curator's role to intercede in those disputes. The letters of curatorship are very clear that the Curator's authority is limited to dealing with your father's estate assets (e.g., including the estate's claims). It is a narrow purview and the Curator cannot exceed that authority.

Also, I am out of the office March 17-21 and 24 for my children's spring break so if there is a lull in activity during that period, it is unavoidable.
