Findings-
Comparison evaluation- None available
5 mm images obtained. Study performed without contrast diminishing sensitivity in an overall evaluation. Automated exposure control and adjustment of the mA and / or kV according to the patient's size were utilized to obtain reduction.
No basal pleural effusion or free air identified. No discrete hepatic mass or biliary dilation. No splenomegaly. No pancreatic or adrenal abnormality. There is questionable loss of fat planes along the course of the descending duodenum. May be some thickening in this area. Lack of oral and IV contrast limit assessment of this area. Differential would include duodenitis or peptic ulcer disease.. No extraluminal gas or fluid collection.
No adenopathy or ascites.
CT pelvis without contrast-
No mass fluid collection or adenopathy.
