TRUSTEE'S RESPONSE TO ELIOT BERNSTEIN'S URGENT MOTION TO RESCHEDULE MARCH 2, 2017 CONTINUATION OF HEARING

Trustee, Ted S. Bernstein ("Trustee"), responds to Eliot Bernstein's ("Eliot") *Urgent Motion to Reschedule March 2, 2017 Continuation of Hearing and Extension of Time*, filed March 1, 2017 (the "Urgent Motion"), and states:

1. The latest Urgent Motion is part of a continuing practice of Eliot to stall or delay these proceedings. Eliot has filed numerous motions for continuance and delay, in this Court and in the Fourth DCA on appeals of order of this Court, always seeking to prevent matters from being heard or decided. This began with his emergency motion to continue the trial set for December 15, 2015 (which had been set three months earlier by order of Judge Phillips). Early the morning of the trial, Eliot filed a voluminous motion for continuance, which Judge Phillips denied.

2. During the appellate proceedings and further proceedings of this Court, Eliot has continued to ask that every matter be delayed or continued for some reason or another, including numerous requests to delay matters for medical reasons. By email dated August 22, 2016 (Ex. 1 attached), Eliot advised that he was unavailable from August 22 through November 5, 2016 – a period of nine weeks which included all of the time Judge Phillips remained on the bench.

3. On November 10, 2016, prior to our first hearing before Your Honor on November 22, 2016, Eliot again requested that the matter be continued and delayed, attaching a doctor's letter claiming he was under too much stress. (Ex 2)

4. Eliot also has filed numerous motions at the Fourth District Court of Appeal seeking

extension and delay. His appeals in Consolidated Case Nos. 4D16-1449, -1476 and -1478 was

dismissed despite his "medical requests." Eliot moved for rehearing, asserting:

10. Contrary to a lack of prosecution, Appellant proceeded to file Motions with this 4th District Court of Appeals pursuing and prosecuting Appellant's rights on 6/28/16; 7/26/16; 8/15/16; 9/6/16 EOT FOR INITIAL BRIEF - NOTICE OF MEDICAL UNAVAILABILITY; 10-13-16 Mot. for Extension of time to file Initial Brief; 10/25/16 NOTICE OF FLORIDA LICENSED MEDICAL DOCTOR INSTRUCTIONS OCT. 24, 2016 AND EXTENSION AND STAY REQUEST; and 11/15/16 "MOTION FOR EXTENSION AFTER DRAFT BRIEF ACTUALLY FILED; FOR STAY AND FURTHER RELIEF".

11. Said motions provided Actual Florida Licensed Medical Doctor's instructions and notice that Appellant was facing life-threatening medical issues and to avoid stress yet has continually been faced with disregard, sharp practices and continuing fraud by the Appellees.

The Fourth DCA denied his motion for rehearing, rejecting the idea that Eliot could indefinitely stall

the appeal of this Court's Guardianship Order. The Orders dismissing the appeals despite Eliot's

claimed medical issues (Ex 3) and denying rehearing (Ex 4) also are attached.

5. These matters have been set for months, since last year. Further, this is a motion to

vacate an order retaining counsel (to which Eliot did not object at the hearing in Septembr) and

seeking to disqualify counsel for an alleged conflict of interest, in a lawsuit between Stansbury and

Estate. The Court has advised Eliot he would have only a few more minutes of cross-examination,

examination which easily could be handled by Mr. Feaman on behalf of the movant, William

Stansbury. As the Court is aware, allegations of disqualification of an attorney are very serious and are taken very seriously by this firm, and should be pursued in an extremely expeditious manner. Both the Trustee and his counsel strongly oppose any delay or continuance of these hearings, which have been set for months.

6. Moreover, there are a number of other matters in both this Estate and the related trust and estate matters which have been set for the same time and scheduled for these hearings, and in most of those cases (Shirley Estate, Shirley Trust) Eliot completely lacks standing. One of the motions involves issues as to counsel for the trial in Illinios, which is now specially set to take place this summer. *Thus, there is urgency to resolving these motion which vastly outweighs any claimed urgent medical issue for Eliot*. Eliot has been having "medical issues" for most of this case, and his tiny interest in this Estate is not sufficient to justify delaying these important hearings or to causing increased delay and expense.

7. Eliot has indicated he could participate in this hearing by telephone, and without objecting to that, the Trustee respectfully requests that this Court deny this latest and successive motion for continuance, and allow Eliot to appear by phone. He was prepared to cross-examine two weeks ago, but we ran out of time. Eliot could easily conclude his questioning of Mr. O'Connell, over our objection, and the Court can hear argument and decide the issue.

8. As a cautionary note, Eliot was allowed to play these games for at least the first year or two of the matter, particularly in the early stages of the matter before Judge Colin. But we now have had a trial to determine the validity of the documents, and a finding by this Court that Ted Bernstein did nothing wrong, yet Eliot continues to persist with his complicated fraud and conspiracy claims in a continued effort to simply derail and delay these proceedings. 9. Judge Phillips conducted not only the trial, resulting in a Final Judgment dated December 16, 2015, but thereafter entered orders determining Eliot's lack of standing and appointing a guardian ad litem to represent his children's interests, finding that Eliot is acting adverse and destructive to them. His actions continue in that vein and should not be allowed by this Court.

10. At a minimum, the Court should conduct the hearing tomorrow to address the numerous other matters which have been pending, and consider at the hearing whether or not to grant a further extension of delay of the disqualification matter.

11. As noted by Mr. O'Connell, he is not available on March 16th, and is still on the witness stand. Although the undersigned could make himself available for hearings on March 16, 2017, at 9:00 a.m., without Mr. O'Connell we should proceed as scheduled tomorrow. The Trustee also reminds the Court that we have a substantial block of time set aside for these hearings and would request that any rescheduled hearing be not only for at least two hours or more, but also specifically include the remaining pending motions which need to be set and heard.

WHEREFORE, the Trustee respectfully requests the Court deny the pending Urgent Motion, and any further relief the Court deems appropriate.


