MINUTE entry before the Honorable John Robert Blakey: Eliot Ivan Bernstein has filed a Notice of Appeal, seeking review of this Court's summary judgment decision. He seeks leave to appeal in forma pauperis. Federal Rule of Appellate Procedure 24(a)(1) requires a party seeking leave to proceed on appeal in forma pauperis to attach an affidavit that: (A) shows in the detail prescribed by Form 4 of the Appendix of Forms the party's inability to pay or to give security for fees and costs; (B) claims an entitlement to redress; and (C) states the issues that the party intends to present on appeal. Eliot's affidavit satisfies subparts (A) and (B): his financial affidavit includes a statement claiming an entitlement to redress and also indicates that he is unemployed and earns no income, that his wife earns less than \$1,600 per month, and that their combined monthly expenses total almost \$3,000. Eliot's affidavit does not, however, set forth the issues he plans to present on appeal, as required by Rule 24(a)(1)(C). In fact, he left that section of the form blank.
